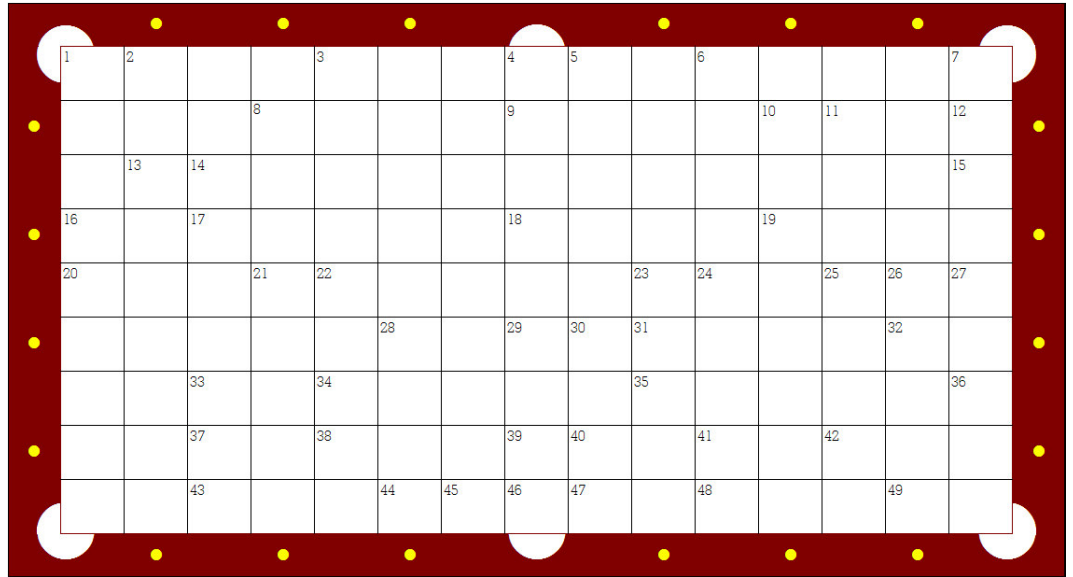


Milt's Puzzle
