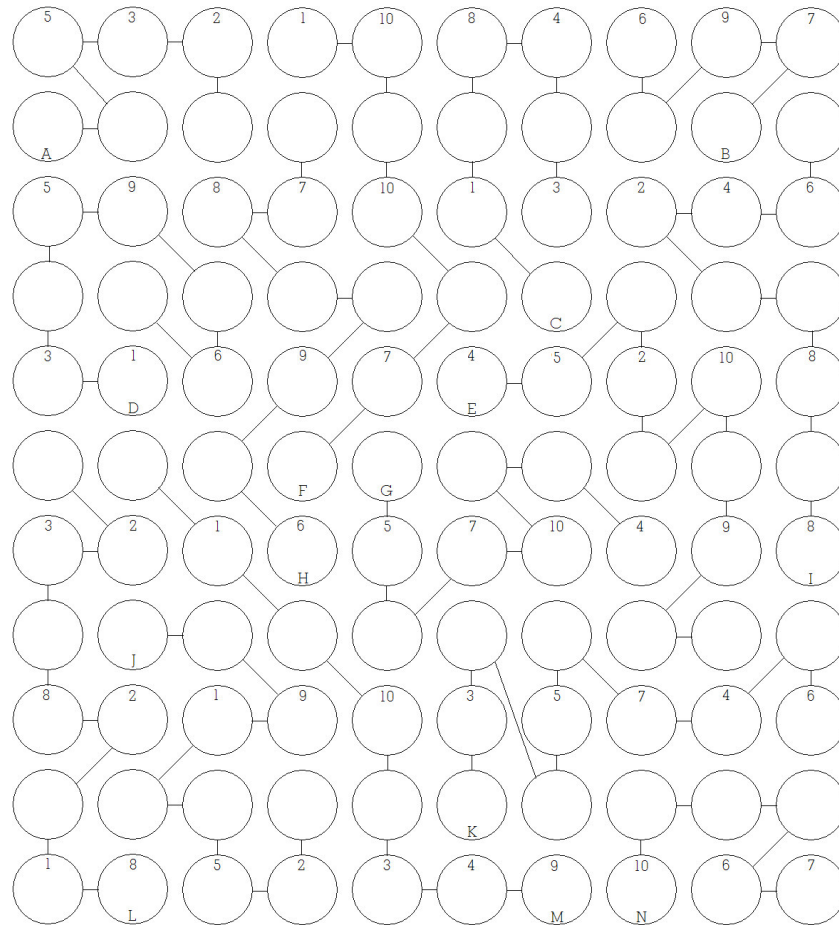


String Theory
