- Basketball player who wore the number 32 for the team in the name of a 1996 movie starring the actor who in 1992 played the producer and actor who in 1913 played a character with a name that's a spoonerized version of his real name in a short comedy *At It Again* 1997
- 1970 Actor who plays a character with the initials JE in an ironic movie about movie credits featuring the actor who provided the voice for a scientist explaining how V-chips work in a 1999 animated feature
