MYSTERY DATE

The recently discovered planet Enigma has a 225-day year, represented in their calendar on the right. Their year is broken up into 15 months (rows), and 15 weekdays (columns). Their holiday schedule was recently discovered; although the weekdays are known, the order of the months are not known.

Clues for the months are in order within each month. Clues for weekdays are all 9-letter answers with no repeated letters. Numbers in the grid represent the nth letter of the weekday's word. (e.g., if ENIGMATIC were the answer, you would enter E in any square with a 1.)

Once finished, solvers should mark the holidays by shading them in.
